

BGMC SPECIAL PROJECT: Project Rescue North Carolina “BGMC Spa Day”



Sexual slavery is devastating children and women around the world. Project Rescue reports:

- **Human trafficking is an estimated \$150 billion dollar industry. This is more than the profits of Microsoft, Apple, Google, Samsung, and Amazon combined.**
- An estimated 30 million individuals worldwide are victims of sexual exploitation.
- 2 million children each year are exploited in the global commercial sex trade.
- Of the millions trafficked across international borders every year, 80 percent are girls and women and 50 percent are minors.

Project Rescue is an Assemblies of God World Missions ministry to children and women victimized by sexual slavery. This ministry is focused on providing physical, emotional, and spiritual rescue and holistic restoration. Through affiliated sites in India, Bangladesh, Nepal, and Moldova, Project Rescue gives exploited children and women a place to call their own—a place of shelter, food, clothing, education, and safety; a place of hope filled with the love of Jesus.

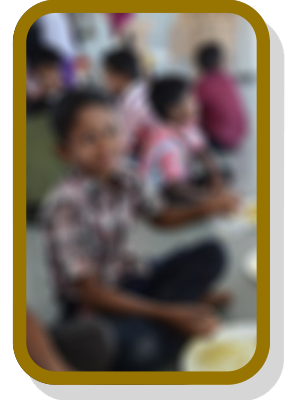
